- Make a bird house. Discuss suitable materials to ensure the food stays dry. Take pictures of it being made and then in place in the garden.
- Create your own character using recyclable materials. Plan and make your model.
- Make a collage of natural materials and objects.
- Research the habitats of a woodland creature. Write a fact-file about the creature. Can you walk in the woods and find one?
- Look in the rooms in your home. Make lists of things made from wood, plastic, metal and fabric. Can you put your results in a bar chart?
- Write a recipe for a snack for the stick family from 'Stick Man'. Make the snack, write the recipe and take photos. How inventive can you be?
- Find out about Axel Scheffler, the illustrator of many Julia Donaldson books. Which country does he come from? Where does he live now? Complete a self portrait in the style of Axel Scheffler.
