

Literacy

This term we will be using a variety of non-fiction and fiction texts to learn about different time periods. We will be looking at 'Man on the Moon' by Simon Bartram. The children will be writing a fictional narrative about their own adventure journey! The children will be researching into what life was like during the Victorian era and writing chronological reports. We will be using a variety of different non-fiction sources to extract information, including the internet. As well as looking into the past, the children will consider what life may be like in the future and look at aspects of space to inspire their writing. All children will have a guided reading session once a week and will be heard to read 1:1 by an adult fortnightly. Please continue to listen to your children read at home 5 times a week.

Numeracy

During this term Year 1 children will be developing their understanding of the relationship between multiplication and division as well solving one-step problems using these two operations. They will then move on to fractions and further develop their understanding of halves and quarters of shapes, objects and amounts. Year 2 will be learning about different measures, including capacity, weight and length. Then they will be going on to look at position and direction as well as revisiting telling the time. Across KS1 we will be revisiting the relationship between the four operations and using these skills to solve problems.

Creative Curriculum

We will be starting our topic with a WOW start. Children will be visiting different time periods, The Victorians, The 60s and the future. The children will experience how a school lesson may have happened during the Victorian era and the 60s and think about the possibilities of the future! During ICT we are learning how to use the internet safely to find facts about the Victorians and Queen Victoria. We will also be comparing our monarchy to that during Victoria's reign. The children will be creating their own family flags and considering timelines of events both within and beyond living memory. We will be completing a science topic to discover the mysteries of our solar system. During RE, we will be looking at the Jewish faith. Our PE lessons will be focused on Athletics and sports day practise. Please ensure your child has a suitable kit for both indoor and outdoor PE and that it is clearly labelled. Their kit must include suitable footwear that they can do up themselves.

The children will be continuing with their 'Successful Learner' wheels and will be encouraged to identify for themselves where they feel they have been successful and developed positive learning skills.
