Re: Crossing by Live and Let Live pub

The safety of children crossing the road by the Live and Let Live Pub has been a concern for many years. In the past, requests for crossings have been rejected. However, this continues to be a highly dangerous place for our children, particularly in the morning.

Cllr Pat Hockey has been working on our behalf to ensure the council prioritise this when making decisions about spending. She has informed us that the council have £50,000 to allocate on local improvements in this financial year. Decisions about the allocation of funding will be made at a public meeting on Thursday December 1st at Shireway Community Association, Shireway, Yate, BS37 8YS. The meeting begins at 7:00p.m.

The traffic management scheme for Park Lane is one of the items being considered. However, not all the schemes being put forward can be funded. Any members of the public have the opportunity to put forward the reasons why their scheme should be prioritised. There will be a considerable number of people attending the meeting to speak about a scheme to stop Frampton End Road being used as a ratrun.

This is a really important opportunity for parents who feel strongly about the dangers of children crossing, to attend the meeting and speak for the crossing to be prioritised. If you cannot attend then please write to the council to express your views. This is a very serious matter. Several children have had narrow misses with cars trying to cross here on their way to school during the last year.
